29TH MAY: ALL GROWLING

Isaiah 59: 9 - 11: We seek justice

An incredibly descriptive image helps us to think about why justice matters, what God feels about it later in the chapter and so why we have it in our vision.

5TH JUNE: ALL AGES

Deuteronomy 6: Pass it on

We want to be a church breaking the national trend of young people leaving in their masses. This passage begins to help us explore how we might do that. This service is an all-age service.

12TH JUNE: ALL BAD?

Isaiah 53: Sin and why it's good

Paddy shares in this standalone talk, why we may have got the wrong view sin and how we can talk about it in a way that heals and not hurts.



19TH JUNE: ALL PRAYING

Matthew 6: Praying like Jesus

Prayer together is an aspect of church life we would love to see growth in. This service looks at the Lord's prayer, teaching about fasting and what God looks at when we pray. It will also feature communion.
